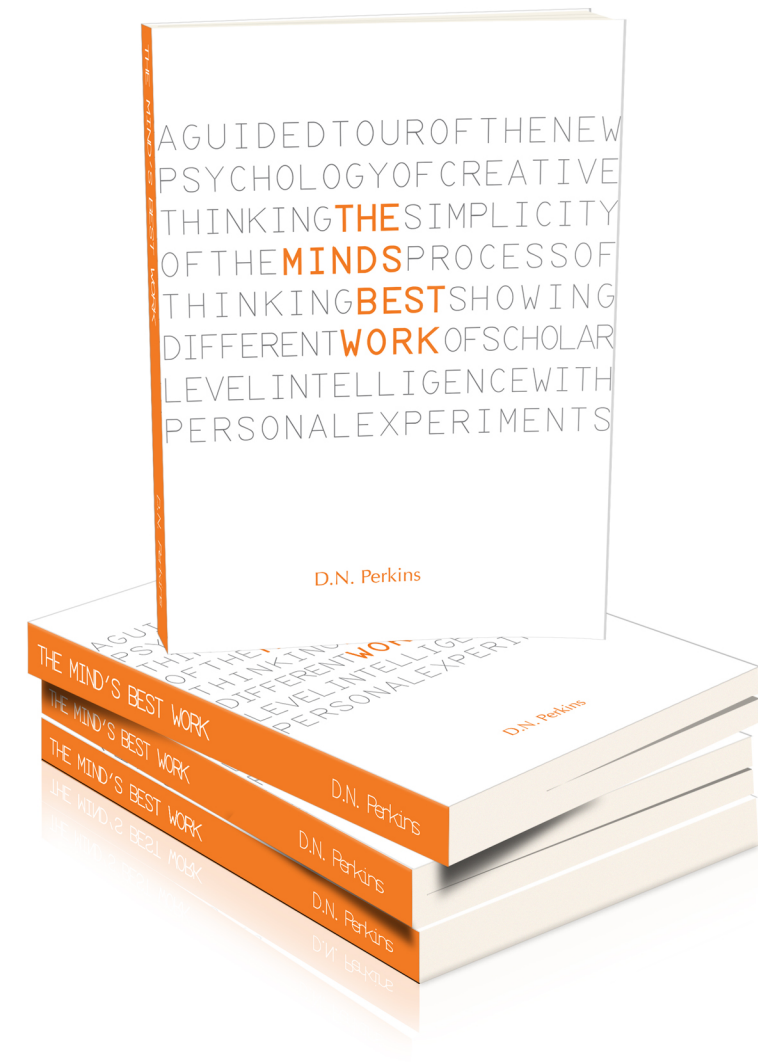

The Luminous Grid Designer Stuart Williams was a man ahead of his time. In 1993, he created the Luminous Earth Grid, sponsored by the New York Foundation for the Arts & San Francisco Intersection for the Arts, to highlight the effect technology would have on our daily life. Spread across ten acres (40,440sq.m, or 435,600sq.ft), 1200 volunteers installed more than 1200 miles (19.3km) of consume electric wire and 1680 energy efficient fluorescent lamps to complete the large-scale sustainable art installation.

"I see the project as a poetic statement on the potential harmony between technology and nature," explains the artist of his work. "The glowing green grid can be seen as an icon of computer imaging technology, which in this 'real life,' incarnation, gently melds with the flowing shape of a lovely landscape... a dream-like vision of symbiotic unity."

Uploading Files to FTP Site

What is FTP?
FTP (File Transfer Protocol) is the simplest and most secure way to exchange files over the Internet. When downloading a file from the Internet, you are actually transferring the file to your computer from another computer over the Web. This is why the letter "T" (transfer) is in FTP.

What FTP program does THP recommend?

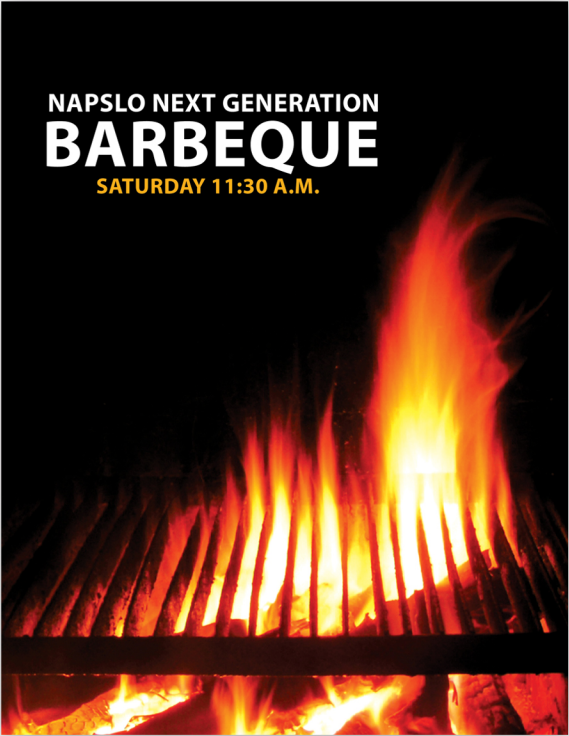
- For Windows users, we recommend Filezilla.
- For Mac users, we recommend CyberDuck.

Should I compress my files before uploading?
Definitely compress files before attempting to transfer them via FTP. Compression protects your files from corruption through the process of transfer as well as makes the transfer process quicker.
